Teodoro.pdf (p.478-638)Gulfstream and Scenic Airlines Gulfstream and Scenic Airlines, Inc. was an airline based in Cincinnati, Ohio. It operated from 1946 to 1969, and from 1971 to 1983. History Gulfstream Airlines was founded by George W. "Georgie" Armstrong, who also founded Ohio Central Airlines. On July 1, 1946, it was renamed Gulfstream-Scenic Airlines, Inc. In 1970, it was renamed Gulfstream. The airline began as a family business, but it was owned and operated by George

Armstrong for the last 22 years of its existence. George founded the airline with his brother, Frank Armstrong, who was general manager and the other brother, Ralph Armstrong, who was the CEO. George was also the pilot, and Ralph was also the flight mechanic. The airline started with two aircraft, a Martin 2-0-2 and a Douglas DC-3. In 1965, a Boeing 737-200 was added, and at that time the fleet consisted of the 737, the DC-3, the Martin 2-0-2, and a Douglas DC-7C. In 1968, the airline was sued by Delta Air Lines in the amount of \$275,000 for an unpaid \$10,000 gift in 1969. In 1969, Gulfstream bought Scenic Airlines from Texas Air Corporation. Texas Air was a small commuter airline, and was also a major sponsor of the Cincinnati Reds. In 1970, Gulfstream added the Boeing 727-100 and Douglas DC-9-10. The DC-9s were manufactured by Boeing, and the 727-100s were built by Douglas. In 1971, Gulfstream and Scenic were merged into one company. It was re-organized as Gulfstream Airways. The new company retained the Gulfstream name. The 727-100s were the last jets to be operated by Gulfstream.
